<u>Labor:</u> \$51.00 per hour. <u>Typical</u> map creation will probably average about 2 hours per map for an estimate of about \$102.00 dollars. This includes both the electronic version (PDF or JPG) and the print version. Sales tax on the print version is required.

<u>Printing:</u> Large format color printing (plotting) is \$4 per square foot. Example: 42" x 54" map is just under 16 square feet, so about \$64. Price will be variable dependent on size.

<u>Spreadsheet</u>: Spreadsheet data is produced from the parcel maps. Estimated time to extract map data into spreadsheet format is approximately 90 minutes producing an estimated cost of \$75.00. We have set a standard configuration (see spreadsheet sample). Different data configuration spreadsheets are possible, but cost may vary.

<u>Labels:</u> Mailing labels are produced using the spreadsheet list in Microsoft Word. Council is to review the spreadsheet and select which records they need for labels. Estimated charge is ½ hour labor plus the cost of the blank labels. Councils could produce labels themselves using the spreadsheet as the list and the Microsoft mail merge feature.
