- How vulnerable is your home?
- If a wildfire came through your neighborhood today, would it be likely to survive intact?
- There is a lot you can do to prepare for the best possible outcome.
- Some fixes are costly, but many others are simple, inexpensive, and easy to do yourself.

This Assessment offered by the Fort Jim Fire Safe Council is in two Parts. The First section utilizes CalFire form QE-100, which covers all defensible space requirements currently required by ordinance.

The second section covers implementing improved Defensible Space actions such as creating a Zone Zero perimeter. Implementing one or more Home Hardening and Defensible Space techniques will reduce your home's vulnerability to wildfires.
