Motion by Zelinsky to approve agenda moving Item 12(a) before Item 10 and to include Items 12(b) and 12(c) with Item 8(c). Second by Pullin. Motion carried.

- Zelinsky asked to have a discussion about the non-partisan endorsement policy added to next month's agenda.
- 5. Consent Agenda: 11/17/2021 Board Meeting Minutes <u>Board Action Item</u>

 Motion by Council to approve consent agenda. Second by Lory. Motion carried.
- **6.** Public Comment –Time limit is 3 minutes per person.
 - Lory: lessons learned by GF FSC from the Caldor Fire-Almer was contacted by USFS and asked for GIS maps for Grizzly Flat roads and he referred them to EDC, Pioneer Fire District wanted aerial maps which Almer gave them, other FSCs should consider having these resources available to them
 - Wirt: received requests during Caldor Fire from agencies looking for water sources: i.e. pools, ponds, hydrants
 - Lubetkin: EDCFSC should consider having EDC GIS department provide presentation on how to get this type of information and how share it
 - Dwyer: Logtown FSC had a sandbox exercise many years ago which was very valuable, brought to light the need for additional information
 - Almos-EDSO OES: individual councils should contact their local fire districts as they are working on pre-attack plans as well as CAL FIRE, FSCs should be a part of the pre-attack process

7. Community Council Reports

- Zelinsky: having educational outreach program on March 19th from 10:00-3:00 at Placerville Town Hall, will have CAL FIRE, city police, fire department, etc., city police is pulling together maps and plans to divide city into four quadrants, hope to create four Firewise Communities
- Barenson: Aukum-Fairplay FSC have been holding meetings via ZOOM, will start holding hybrid meeting tonight, received their 2022 Firewise certificate
- Lubetkin: Oak Hill Area FSC is working to schedule a community clean-up day on March 12th at the Oak Hill fire station
- Payne: would be happy to help other FSCs with working through grant process
- Martin: send any meeting/event dates and she will put them on the EDCFSC website Events Calendar
- Wirt: looking for help getting grants-will connect with Payne, holding hybrid meetings

- Ball: Strawberry FSC has a community meeting planned for May, needs help finding a speaker for home hardening-will connect her with H Campbell
- Dwyer: Logtown FSC received 2022 Firewise certificate, will be meeting tomorrow, E-Board will be working
 on agenda and schedule for year, planning community clean-up day in May and hot dog social in October, all
 other months will have a speaker for their second Saturday meetings
- Hawk: Gold Ridge Forest FSC received 2022 Firewise certificate
- Council: Texas Hill Estates FSC received 2022 Firewise certificate, scheduled to start roadside clearance work in March
- Parlin: the Wildfire Resiliency group that BOS put together in the fall is due to report in March

- a. Chairman's Report & Communication:
 - No report
- b. Vice Chair Report
 - Meeting hall is still a work in progress, now have microphones for audience and high speed internet, planning on adding cameras and monitors
 - EDC Fire Safe Coordinator position description is ready to go, waiting for BOS's ok, Egbert is ready to house Coordinator
 - State Fire Marshall has a list of approved WUI products on its website, will add a link to EDCFSC website
 - Met with Aurora Mullett, insurance broker, and she has agreed to start attending the EDCFSC meetings to be available to answer questions and give updates on insurance issues
- c. Secretary Report:
 - The insurance company charges a per event fee, current coverage includes 10 events at \$500,
 - Need to be clear on event insurance applications as to if contractors are doing work (chain sawing, chipping, moving dumpsters, etc.) or if volunteers are doing the work, if volunteers are doing this kind of work request must be pre-approved by E-Board due to additional liability and cost
 - There was a FSC that did a Go Fund Me fundraiser without pre-approval which may affect our non-profit status and reporting requirements, if an individual does a Go Fund Me donations are considered a gift, if a non-profit does one there may be liability, will bring back to Board when a resolution is reached
 - Johnston: is familiar with reporting requirements for non-profits and will connect with Pullin
- d. Treasurers Report: Maureen **Board Action Item** Pimlott
 - Full report was included in board packet
 - Over budget in IT and computer supplies which is directly related to upgrading the meeting hall, all overages were approved by the E-Board
 - Received CAL FIRE chipping grant advance of \$150,000 and \$5,000 for DS program
 - Accountant is still working on taxes, hope to have them soon for the Finance Committee to review
 - Zelinsky: appreciates expanded financial reports

Motion by Zelinsky to accept Treasurer's Report. Second by Lory. Motion carried.

 - 1. Chiefs Meeting Mike Lilienthal Phillips
 - Chiefs will be meeting today, Tim Cordero, EDC Fire is chair
 - Scheduled to discuss proposed regulatory changes at local level for campfires in March
 - Chiefs and FPO are working on Rural Water Supply and Draft Hydrant standard update
 - CAL OES announced a new grant called Prep California, \$15 million available state-wide, up to \$1 million per application for planning for preparedness, not eligible for CWPP or equipment purchases, due February 28th
 - 2. FPO Meeting Ron Phillips
 - Marshall Cox will continue as chair
 - Recommended to Chiefs that new developments be required to provide WUI fire safe plan and to develop a standard
 - Payne: urgency rebuild permits are requiring fire sprinklers, this is difficult for rural areas with little water supply, Phillips: homeowners can use pressure tanks or water storage tanks
 - Title 14 fire regulations updates are still under review, public comments closed yesterday, next step is public hearing

- Zelinsky: EDC Chamber of Commerce is concerned about road access regulations for agricultural or industrial uses for existing businesses, Phillips: no update needed for existing use, new construction will have to meet new standards
- 3. CAL FIRE Patrick McDaniel
 - Send him scope of work and map for current grant cycle and he will forward to field battalions for comments to help with application, need soon-by end of week
- 4. ENF Updates Teresa Riesenhuber
 - No report
- 5. BLM Jason Schroeder Lee Helgeson
 - Still working with Georgetown FSC on Shoo Fly area project,
 - Working with Bureau of Reclamation to partner for a management plan for land on EDC/Placer County border
 - Not anticipating much prescribed burning in EDC this year, maybe some in Pine Hill Reserve near Salmon Falls Road
 - Can be reached at dhelgeson@blm.gov (yes, his email is Dhelgeson not Lhelgeson)
 - Lubetkin: EDC Resource Advisor Committee has grant coming up for money to use on federal lands
 - Parlin: working with partners on grazing project
 - Connelly: Auburn Lake Trails FSC has been meeting with Bureau of Reclamation to maintain shaded fuel break
 - Johnston: BLM has defensible space permissions to allow for neighboring properties to treat federal lands

 - Taking action with system hardening projects, enhanced vegetation management, enhanced power line safety settings
 - Starting work on project in Cool
 - Working on remote grid for rural customers, hope to have 250 in place in the next ten years
 - Report It app allows for downloading photos
 - Set up notifications in app, don't need to be a PG&E customer to use
 - New cameras in north end of county in partnership with CAL FIRE
 - Can be contacted at mike.webb@pge.com
 - Payne: Diamond Springs parkway project is an underground district
 - Zelinsky: what is the difference between a remote grid and a micro grid? a remote grid is free standing, a micro grid is generated during PSPS

- a. Chipping Pat/Jodi
 - Up and running
 - Contractors are responsive, only delays have been due to weather and power outages
- b. Defensible Space Ernie/Jodi
 - Looking at opening program to applications in March and starting evaluations in April
 - Considering hiring contractor to do evaluations
 - Mainly funded by \$100,000 PG&E grant through CA FSC, funding runs until the end of October, calling it 100 Safer Seniors
 - Question as to if individual councils need additional insurance to do one-on-one evaluations, will have Pullin check with insurance agent

12. Committee Reports

- a. Grants & Funding Pat
 - 15 grants currently on the books, nearly \$4 million dollars
 - Four are coming to the end of the grant period and will need to be closed out: Weber Creek, old chipping grant, CWPP and Patterson Ranch
 - Grants Committee has met and has six proposals for EDCFSC to be fiscal sponsor, Auburn Lake
 Trails FSC and Placerville/Texas Hill Estates FSCs will be applying with other fiscal sponsors
 - Strawberry FSC will use EDCFSC start-up monies for initial outreach
 - Looking a community clean-up grant from PG&E for next year
 - Discussion on road clearance guidelines, would like to use PG&E guidelines and remove potential hazards even if they are not directly in the right of way
 - Wildfire is the single biggest threat to the county but EDC does not have a single point of contact for addressing this

- Parlin: agrees that there needs to be a single point of contact at EDC, hopes that the Wildfire Resiliency group will take this role
- Schnell: EDC doesn't qualify for FEMA grant due to the government combining census area

WHEREAS: The EDCFSC bylaws state: The authorized number of directors shall be no less than 5 and no more than 21, until changed by amendment to these Bylaws, and

WHEREAS: The EDCFSC currently has more than 21 AFSCs and wishes to increase the number of directors:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the EDCFSC Board of Directors amend Section 5.02 Number of Directors of the bylaws to read:

The authorized number of directors shall be no less than five and a maximum equal to the current number of AFSC's plus Member at Large members duly elected by the Board of Directors, until changed by amendment to these Bylaws. The Board of Directors is a representative body made up of, but not limited to, delegates from the Associate Fire Safe Councils (AFSC's) and Members at Large throughout El Dorado County. When new AFSC's are formed, the Board of Directors will solicit a representative to serve as Director on the EDCFSC Board. Interested individuals not associated with an AFSC can be considered for Board membership as a Member at Large. Candidates must submit an Application for Board Membership (Section 6, Form 4) and provide their qualifications. These candidates for Director may be nominated upon submittal of the application and elected and seated at the next regularly scheduled meeting as an Interim Director, with voting privileges, until the next annual election at which time the Interim Director(s) can be elected for a two year term in accordance with procedures as stated in Section 5.05. This process will assist in identifying specific local community issues and encourage participation in the strategic planning of the EDCFSC to identify projects, increase public education and outreach to the residents of El Dorado County in accordance with our Mission Statement.
